- Internationally Recognized Programs (e.g. Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, etc.)
- Career Choices (e.g. CTS, Green Certificate, Exploratory Programs, Registered Apprenticeship Program, etc.)
- Post-Secondary advanced certification through dual credit programming
- Athletic Academies (e.g. Hockey, Dance, Soccer, Baseball)
- Language based-programming (e.g. language immersion programs, German, Ukrainian, Chinese Bilingual, locally-developed language courses, etc.)
- International travel exchanges for students and teachers
- Philosophy based programs (e.g. Cogito, Montessori, gifted and talented, Caraway, and Indigenous programs)
- Programming for students with unique or complex learning needs (eg. Headstart, pre-kindergarten, specialized programs)
- Fine arts, Drama, and Music programming
- Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math Programming (STEM)
- Faith-based programming (e.g. LOGOS, Maranatha, locally-developed religious studies)
- Program setting & delivery (e.g. online, outreach, distance education, blended homeschool, etc.)
