Alberta School Boards Association 2021 Long Service Award

Background

The Long Service Awards Program recognizes significant contribution to trusteeship.

Prior to the change in legislation, long service award recipients received an ASBA pin inscribed with their years of service – 9-21 yrs (three to seven terms) at their respective Zone Annual Meeting. Individuals who served for 24 years (eight terms) received a gold pocket watch or crystal bowl at their respective Zone Annual Meeting. The Association made a donation of the recipient's choice to an educational charity for individuals who served for 27 years (nine terms) or over.

The Alberta Legislative Assembly passed a bill in December 2012 amending the Local Authorities Election Act. Starting with the 2013 municipal elections, school trustees are elected for a four-year term and municipal elections are moved to a four-year cycle. Prior to this change, officials were elected for a three-year term and municipal elections took place on a three-year cycle.

At their December 2014 meeting, the ASBA Zone Chairs approved that the Association amend the long service award recognition program to align with the four-year term election cycle. Given that a trustee may have been elected prior to the change in legislation, their years of service would be a factor of three. Being re-elected after the change in legislation, their years of service now becomes a factor of four. Since there are numerous variations on total years of service, especially for returning trustees, the change to the long service awards program will reflect terms of service, rather than years of service.

Criteria

- A trustee serving a minimum of two terms is eligible to receive a long service award.
 - A trustee must have served a minimum of half a term for that term to qualify towards long service.
 - A trustee elected in a by-election in their first term who served a minimum of 75 percent of their second term is eligible to receive a long service award.
- A trustee may include terms of service prior to the change in legislation which increased terms from 3 years to 4 years.
- Non-continuous service will be taken into account.
- Deadline for nominations is **September 17, 2021**

Procedural Guidelines

A recognition form along with the questionnaire on page 4 must be completed and submitted to the Zone chair on or before the nomination deadline.

* Trustees will normally be recognized with long service awards in the Fall of a year a Local Authorities Election is to occur. As such, applications for long service will normally be made in Fall 2021. An application should be made prior to Fall 2021 only if a trustee will not be completing the full four-year term or they are not running again in 2021 Election.

Awards Presentation

Long service award recipients will now receive a certificate with their terms of service (a minimum of 2 terms) at their respective Zone Annual Meeting. The Association will recognize these recipients at the Fall General Meeting.
