Enrolling approximately 120 Indigenous students, school staff work collaboratively with each other and the local communities to meet the learning needs of each student. Lytton has a vibrant community spirit, and is within easy driving distance of Fraser Valley communities and Vancouver.

The candidate we seek will have a professional profile which includes:

- Demonstrated commitment to and experience in instructional leadership and supervision of learning.
- Knowledge and understanding of evidence based teaching and learning strategies in school improvement, student achievement and staff development.
- Demonstrated commitment to inclusion, truth and reconciliation.
